09/007 The Cheshire Council (Footpath No. 49 (part) Parish of Haslington Borough of Crewe and Nantwich)

Further to Min. 09/852 dated 24th March 2009 in which the Town Council lodged a strong objection to the proposed diversion of footpath 49, members considered whether or not to reconsider the objection in the light of the information now received.

09/008 Parking Enforcement – Cheshire East

The intention is that the whole of the Borough would fall within the Special Parking Area and that powers would be implemented on 30th September 2009.
